***Placement in Regional Programs within the SELPA -  
Policy and Procedures***

---

A pupil may be placed in a special education program operated by a district other than the District of Residence (or operated by the County Superintendent) upon the recommendation of the Individualized Education Program (IEP) team, review and approval by the receiving district and the Administrator of the SELPA. Placement may be in a Special Day Class or Center.

Contingent upon approval as described in paragraph one, no regional program agreements are required between the SELPA and districts within the SELPA boundaries or between two districts that may have an exchange of students where one district operates a program from which such student(s) would benefit.

In those cases where students from districts outside the SELPA are placed pursuant to an Individualized Education Program (IEP) recommendation to attend programs operated within the SELPA, whether county or district-operated, an agreement between the SELPA and the county from which the student comes is required. Approval must be obtained from the Administrator of the SELPA and an inter-SELPA agreement is required prior to placement.

In an instance where a parent of a pupil is choosing to enroll their child in another district outside the IEP process, that child will follow the relevant LEA inter-district transfer permit process as any other child and is subject to the same inter-district processes as a child without exceptional needs.
